Council discussed how to go about fixing Garden Avenue and Burton Street. Mark Osborn discussed estimated costs from different people with different suggestions such as hot mix, crushed rock and concrete base. These streets are designated as truck route and will need more than normal streets to hold up to traffic. They are also highly visible in the center of town. Mark will return with more information at a later meeting.

Councilperson Spann made a motion to approve business item C. Authorization for City Administrator to open a new checking account at Eden State Bank for the purpose of paying and tracking pre-construction engineering fees for USDA water/wastewater project and to make an initial transfer of \$100,000 from account 6041 into the new account, seconded by Councilperson Hall, motion carried.
